This unusual Easter spectacle is free to register your vehicle and provides a chance for the whole family to experience the sights and sounds of old England through a history of transportation. Showcasing how everything from eggs to beer was transported, with over 100 horse drawn vehicles, carriages, and horses ranging from Shetlands to Shires, together with a parade of vintage and classic cars, tractors and motorcycles. You can even take a ride back in time on the Fullers Brewery Dray pulled by two of their magnificent Shires.

The parade starts at 9.00 am with car exhibitors forming part of a static display whilst the judging of the horse drawn vehicles is taking place. Before the final horse drawn vehicle parade, the cars & other vehicles then take part in their own parade giving spectators the chance to see the vehicles on the move. The final parade takes place at approx. 1.00 pm with the day finishing at about 2.30 pm.
